Barbara Uliasz-Misiak is a professor at AGH, Faculty of Drilling, Oil and Gas. Her professional interests are geothermal energy, CO₂ geological and energy storage, utilisation of the deep subsurface, environmental aspects of hydrocarbon exploration and exploitation, hydrogeology.

She has worked as a geologist in MEERI PAS (main focus: studies of geothermal energy and CO₂ storage) in 1997-2010. Barbara has taken part in three FP6 projects (CO₂Sink, EU GeoCapacity and CO₂ReMoVe), Polish-Norwegian Research Programme project and four national research projects, all related to geological storage of carbon dioxide. Leader of the Polish research team in CO₂Sink Project. She has also taken part in three national research projects related to geothermal energy recognition and exploitation.

Author and co-author of more than 100 scientific publications. Barbara possesses MSc degree in applied geology and PhD in mining and geology from AGH University of Science and Technology in Krakow.
